A fresh and delicate aroma, reminiscent of spices and dry fruit, acquired during oak ageing. In the mouth this is an elegant wine that shows a fine balance between structure and sweetness, providing it with an attractive, long finish.

The intense aroma is dominated by very ripe black fruit (blackcurrant, blackberry and prune), along with chocolate, cocoa, floral aromas and a slight hint of spices (pepper). In the mouth it is a full-bodied wine with great balance between sweetness and richness of structure.

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy
Wild berries and savoury spice characterise this round, seductive example of the local grape Teroldego. Velvety in the mouth, with a juicy freshness, this is both delicious and distinctive. | £24.50 |
| 26 | NéPriCa (Negroamaro/Primitivo/Cabernet), Tormaresca
Puglia IGT, Italy
Red fruits, black cherry and blackcurrant on the nose. On the palate, the spice of the Negroamaro is complemented by the juicy plum flavours of Primitivo, resulting in a soft and well-balanced wine. | £26.50 |
| 27 | Cloof Pinotage
Darling, South Africa
The bold, concentrated flavours of this wine are directly attributable to the tiny yield of mature bush vines growing under extreme conditions. Richly textured with notes of smoke, blackberry, plum with some spiciness and elegant oaky notes. | £26.95 |
| 28 | Prunus Dao Tinto
Dão, Portugal
Lightly oaked and perfectly balanced, with a silky texture and crisp edge. The nose is cram-packed with mulberries, blackberries and anise. On the palate black cherry and raspberry fruit tones with creamy and chocolaty oak flavours. | £27.50 |

Rhône Valley, France
With Syrah to the fore, this is full of berry fruit, violet, liquorice, and spices. It has a generous, rounded palate and a long, elegant finish. | Magnum £55.00

Piedmont, Italy
Fragrant on the nose with hints of plum and cherry. On the palate it is well structured and soft, showing the typical red fruit and bright character of the Barbera variety. | £29.50 |

Hawkes Bay, New Zealand
This charming wine offers aromas of blackberry, raspberry, smoky oak and floral notes. Sweet ripe cherry and raspberry flavours complement the fine structure and subtle spicy oak. The finish is long and soft, with elegant raspberry fruit. | £29.95 |
| 32 | Brouilly Chateau de la Perrière
Burgundy, France
This juicy Brouilly shows a fine spectrum of fruit, especially raspberries, Morello cherries and blackcurrants. There is some typical Brouilly power on the palate, but a good deal of finesse as well. | £32.50 |
| 33 | Three Gardens Shiraz Grenache Mourvedre, Langmeil
South Australia
This classic blend shows lifted aromas of black cherry and blueberry with hints of mocha, spice and white pepper. The palate has luscious fruit contained within a refreshing, medium-bodied style. | £35.00 |
| 34 | Château Lalande de Gravet
Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France
Delicious ripe Saint-Emilion, with plum and redcurrant fruit allied to a fruitcake-style richness. | £52.50 |

Burgundy, France
Sleek, aromatic burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Full in the mouth yet beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that come from old vines. | £65.00 |

Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish. | £28.00 |
| 37 | Conde Valdemar Rioja Reserva
Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and black fruit touches, leading to a generous, intense palate full of raisins and chocolate. Beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish. | £75.00

| 38 | Conde Valdemar Rioja Gran Reserva
On the nose, it shows spicy aromas of black pepper and vanilla combined with ripe black fruit. Round and full-bodied, good balance between the fruit and the oak, with a persistent finish. | £58.00 |

- 1 **Valdemoreda Macabeo** £17.50
Spain
This fresh dry Macabeo displays well-defined fruity aromas of peach and apple, with floral notes. Fresh and rounded in the mouth, with a long, smooth aftertaste of flowers and fruit.
- 2 **Kleinkloof Sauvignon Blanc** £18.50
Paarl, South Africa
On the nose the wine shows hints of ripe gooseberry, green apple and citrus. On the palate the wine has an uplifting intensity with stone fruit, citrus and green apple flavours that are refreshing and long-lasting.
- 3 **First Fleet Chardonnay** £19.95
South-Eastern Australia
A delicious Chardonnay that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a crisp, modern style. Red apple and melon fruit fills a palate that is dry yet well rounded, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.
- 4 **Nina Garganega/Pinot Grigio** £21.95
Veneto, Italy
Crisp apple and pear fruit aromas with some floral overtones lead to a soft, medium-bodied palate with a clean, dry finish.
- 5 **Santa Alvara Sauvignon Blanc** £21.95
Central Valley, Chile
This crisp Sauvignon Blanc offers aromas of gooseberry and elderflower, leading to a refreshing medium-bodied palate with green apple fruit flavours and a citrus kick on the finish.
- 6 **Chenin Blanc Kanu** £21.95
Stellenbosch, South Africa
A nose of melon, flowers and savoury notes with some honey-spiced fruit leads to a tropical palate that combines depth of fruit with a bright, crisp finish.
- 7 **Prunus Dao Branco** £22.95
Dão, Portugal
Well-rounded and harmonious, with notes of tinned peaches and fresh herbs, a fresh juicy palate and a long, mouthwatering finish.
- 8 **Gaillac Blanc, Château Lions Lamartine** £24.00
South West, France
A broad spread of aroma – mandarin, apricot, white flowers – leads to a rich, expressive palate bursting with fruit and yet with a certain crispness that keeps it fresh and lively. Really characterful, distinctive white wine.
- 9 **Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac** £25.50
Languedoc Roussillon, France
- 10 **Viognier, Delas** £27.50
Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.
- 11 **White Rabbit Riesling** £28.50
Rhein, Germany
A multifaceted Riesling, versatile with or without food. Redolent of grass and herbs; here and there, a whiff of white blossoms and tropical fruit. Balanced and beautifully refreshing.
- 12 **Regaleali Bianco (Catarratto/Inzolia/Greco)** £29.00
Sicilia IGT, Italy
Delicately fruity nose with apple, peach and pink grapefruit notes. The palate is quite intense and crisp, with plenty of fresh fruit flavours.
- 13 **Gavi di Gavi La Contessa** £29.95
Piedmont, Italy
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry.

- 14 **Featherdrop Sauvignon Blanc** £25.50
Marlborough, New Zealand
Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalize the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.
- 15 **Zero-G Gruner Veltliner** £32.00
Wagram, Austria
Light in body yet intensely flavoured, this Grüner Veltliner offers the typical white pepper and crisp green fruit aromas of the variety, allied to a creamy texture particular to the Wagram region.
- 16 **Sancerre Le Mont, Cherrier** £45.00
Loire, France
Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.
- 17 **Chablis, JM Brocard** £45.00
Burgundy, France
The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose.
- 18 **Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, JM Brocard** £65.00
Burgundy, France
Spicy notes with flint and citrus fruit aromas on the nose, followed by a subtle palate showing beautiful minerality and notes of lemon.

Spain
Complex ripe fruit aromas with subtle spicy hints of vanilla and caramel thanks to five months in oak. Rounded and well balanced in the mouth with a full, long aftertaste.
- 20 **Visconti della Rocca Primitivo** £18.50
Puglia, Italy
Intense, fruity Primitivo full of jammy plum fruit and savoury spice. Smooth-textured with a lick of vanilla on the finish.
- 21 **First Fleet Shiraz** £19.95
South-Eastern Australia
A vibrant Shiraz that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a modern, easy-drinking style. Mulberry and plum fruit mixes with spice on the smooth-textured palate, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.
- 22 **Santa Alvara Merlot** £21.95
Central Valley, Chile
Smooth, juicy Merlot full of ripe plum and red berry fruit, medium weight and slightly spicy on the palate, and with a generous fruit-filled finish.
- 23 **Norton Porteño Malbec** £24.00
Mendoza, Argentina
This luscious Malbec has aromas of violets, strawberries and black cherries, leading to a smooth, full-bodied palate with a hint of peppery spice.
- 24 **Carignan La Galiniere, Coteaux de Peyriac** £24.50
Languedoc-Roussillon, France
Rich strawberry and plum aromas combine with Carignan's typical spicy, mustard complexity in this hearty, concentrated red. The palate offers an enticing combination of juicy fruit and herbal, savoury notes, making this a versatile food wine.
